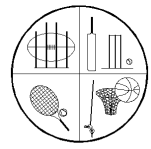

CRICKET

Going into the Christmas/New Year break, we had 5 of 6 senior sides in the finals race. The 1st and 2nd XI had some disappointing performances in January/February resulting in both sides dropping out of finals contention. Our 3rd XI go into a Grand Final this weekend after a rain affected semi-final in which they were extremely well placed. The 4th XI were also in a semi-final appearance last weekend, but the rain
